Port Talbot South Pocket and Old Channel Dredging Campaign

Beginning on or around Thursday June 4th 2020 for a period of 8 days the UKD Bluefin will be carrying out dredging work in the Port Talbot South Pocket and Old Channel area. Mariners are advised to be aware and take extra caution when on their approach to the port of Port Talbot.

Beginning on or around Friday June 19th 2020 for a period of 7 days the UKD Cherry Sand will be carrying out dredging work in the Port Talbot South Pocket and Old Channel area. Mariners are advised to be aware and take extra caution when on their approach to port of Port Talbot.

Beginning on or around Thursday June 25th 2020 for a period of 7 days the UKD Sealion will be carrying out dredging work in the Port Talbot South Pocket and Old Channel area. Mariners are advised to be aware and take extra caution when on their approach to the port of Port Talbot.

The vessels will display lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16 and 12.
