

Notice to Mariners – December 2016

****Update February 2017****

General: As part of a marine mammal observation program the Severn Estuary/Bristol Channel area, Titan Environmental Surveys will be deploying and maintaining seabed based scientific equipment at **five** sites in the area, for an expected period of **12 months**.

The instrumentation will be sited on the seabed and connected to a ground-line which will in turn connect to a mooring weight. The mooring weight anchors the surface mark.
