Sanctions against Russian Shipping

Notice is hereby given to Masters, Shipping agents, Charterers and Ship operators of all vessels, which includes Commercial, Leisure and Fishing due for the 5 South Wales Ports.

With immediate effect the Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) (Amendment) (No 4) regulations 2022 will be complied by all ABP South Wales Ports.

The regulations prohibit Russian ships, and other ships specified by the Secretary of State from entering ports in the United Kingdom.
