## Newport Dock, Port Talbot South Pocket and Cardiff Wrach Channel Dredging Campaign

Mariners are advised that the following UKD vessels will be conducting dredging campaigns in Newport dock, Port Talbot South pocket and Cardiff wrach channel. Mariners are advised to be aware and take extra caution when on their approach to the ports of Newport, Port Talbot and Cardiff.

UKD Sealion – Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2022 for 6 days in Newport Dock.

UKD Cherry Sand – Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2022 for 6 days in Port Talbot South pocket.

UKD Orca – Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 for 3 days in Port Talbot South pocket

UKD Sealion -Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> of July 2022 for 4 days in Port Talbot South pocket

UKD Orca – Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> July 2022 for 6 days in Cardiff wrach channel

The vessels will display lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea, and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16, 71, 68 and channel 12.
