## NOTICE TO MARINERS.

### Port Talbot Geophysical Survey

Mariners are advised that ABPmer are scheduled to undertake a Geophysical survey in Port Talbot at various locations detailed on the 2<sup>nd</sup> page of this notice (Map). Expected dates of the survey are Sunday May 5<sup>th</sup> 2024 – Wednesday May 15<sup>th</sup> 2024. Intended hours of operation are between 0600hrs – 2100hrs.

Vessel will be the “Wessex Explorer” Call sign 2WWE, and they will monitor VHF Channels 12 and 16.

Multiple instruments will be towed from the stern of the vessel, up to 100m behind the vessel. Some sensors will be towed on the surface, others at depth. Vessel will be turning regularly.

Survey vessel will have restricted manoeuvrability and all vessels are requested to keep a minimum 100m clearance from the survey vessel. Towed sensors will be limited within Port Talbot Old Dock
