Temporary Training Works of Dredging Fleet off Port of Barry

Mariners are advised that temporary training works of the Hinkley dredging fleet will take place between Saturday July 31st – Tuesday August 10th 2021. The training will take place within a box bounded between the following coordinates.

51 21.5N – 003 22W
51 22.3N – 003 22W
51 21.5N – 003 18.5W
51 22.3N – 003 18.5W

The split hopper barges, towed backhoe dredger and supporting craft will transit to and from this area to the Hinkley Point C (HPC) offshore site, Barry and Avonmouth.

Vessels involved in the training include the split hopper barges (SHB) MV Sloeber and Pagadder, Trailing suction hopper dredger MV Artevelde, Backhoe dredger barge (BHD) MV Peter the Great, Tug Noordstroom, Crew/Security vessel Commander P and accommodation vessel DP Gezina.

Training will include simulated dredging, SHB conducting circuits and mooring/unmooring alongside BHD, BHD spudding and moving locations, crew vessel manoeuvring between the vessels, MOB drills, environmental boom deployment drills and anchoring.
