NOTICE TO MARINERS.

NO 49 of 2021

River Tawe Swansea

Dear valued ABP customers and stakeholders.

Craft owners using the River Tawe, above the tidal barrage and the Marina, at Swansea should be aware that there are at this time large semi submerged and possibly submerged objects floating in the main river watercourse, causing a hazard to navigation. Therefore, proceeding with caution is advised.

It should be noted that on the 14th October a Craft proceeding upriver struck a substantial submerged object which caused slight impact damage to the hull.

The approximate location details of the contact in the river at that time were:

51 degrees 38' 04.9" N and 3 degrees 56' 02.8" W

That is Approximately 2 kilometres or 1.25 miles, to the North and upstream from the Marina.

Again, craft owners/users are advised to proceed with caution.
